Please ring before 12.30pm to request a visit. Please note that home visits are for house bound patients only and at the doctors' discretion. The GP may wish to speak to you before deciding on whether a visit is necessary.

REGISTRARS & MEDICAL STUDENTS

We will often have a trainee GP in post. These are qualified doctors who are completing their general practice training in Queen Camel. They are normally in post for 1 year and will see patients in the same way as the partners. Occasionally Medical Students will be present with the doctor and patients will be informed by a note on the book-in screen. They are normally with us for 2 weeks and will only see patients under supervision.

ACCESS TO MEDICAL RECORDS

The practice is registered and complies with the Data Protection Act 1998. Any request for access to notes by a patient, patient's representative or outside body will be dealt with in accordance with the Act. Please contact the Practice Manager for further information.

Your health records contain a type of data called confidential patient information. This data can be used to help with research and planning. You can choose to stop your confidential patient information being used for research and planning. You can also make a choice for someone else like your children under the age of 13. Your choice will only apply to the health and care system in England. This does not apply to health or care services accessed in Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland.

MEDICINES

The dispensary is open from **8.45 am to 1.00 pm** and then from **3.00 pm to 6.00 pm**.

Please note that as of the 1st April 2023 we no longer accept answer phone messages as a method of requesting medication. This is for safety reasons.

To speak to a dispenser please phone between **9.30 and 11am**. We require 1 weeks' notice to make up repeat prescriptions. Only certain patients are eligible to receive dispensing services and unfortunately, we cannot offer dispensary services to a patient who lives within one mile of a local pharmacy (as the crow flies). This is an NHS regulation.

FACILITIES


- The premises are suitable for wheelchairs.
